WHY THE RUSH TO AUTOMATION?



Automation Isn't New...

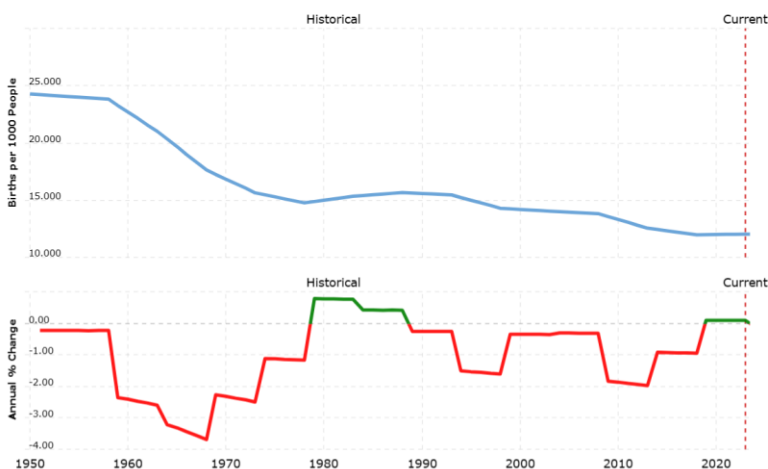
- One could argue that **automation dates to the early days of manufacturing lines**...Ford's Model T, for instance
 - Ford standardized how workers built the vehicle and, because of that, they were able to **mass produce the Model T at a lower per-unit cost**
 - Further, **standardization helped to increase the quality and reliability of the vehicle**
- Today's automation efforts seek to do the same: *work efficiently, with higher quality and reduced errors*

The Labor Shortage: A New Driver



- Today's **labor shortage** has created an additional driver for **automation efforts**
 - There simply are not enough qualified workers to do all the work that needs to be done
 - This condition was going to happen with or without COVID
- Consider the chart on the next slide...

US Birth Rate From 1950



- The **birth rate in the US (and most other countries)** has **declined precipitously** since 1950
- Today, 12.023 people are born each year per 1,000 people in the population

Automation Is Critical For Success



- What can/should you automate?
 - Look for transactions with **one or more of the following characteristics**

Repetitive transactions

- Monthly journal entries

Transactions requiring entry into a database

- Entering W-2 forms into a personal tax return

Standardized transactions with little variability

- Accounts payable bills from the same vendor

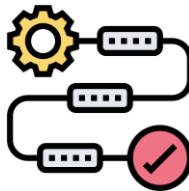

Automation Risks



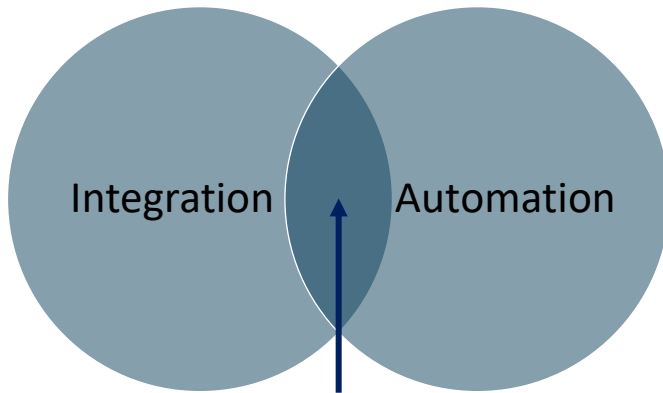
- Data access paradox – creating barriers to high-quality data
- New cybersecurity threats – privileged accounts are trusted
- Magnified data management issues – real-time needed to scale
- Complacency – once in place, not reviewed
- Governance isn't a given – review workflows and guardrails
- Overdependence on automation – institutional knowledge loss

What Is Integration?



- Integration allows data/information to be easily shared between systems without human intervention
- The integration process is usually automated and occurs on an "events basis" (e.g., issuing an invoice, creating a customer record) or on a "scheduled basis" (e.g., once an hour, once a week, etc.)
- Generally, integration programming follows the same workflow procedures as if a human operator had done the work themselves. It's about moving data between systems



What Is Automation?



- In business, automation is focused on the performance of a task without the need for human labor
- Humans design automation procedures, but the work is performed between systems. Once initiated, it will continuously run on its own until intervention is required
- An example of simple automation would be the thermostat in your home or fridge. It will maintain the temperature once set
- A complex automation would be your car's traction control system that automatically adjusts based on multiple real-world conditions



Why Are Integration And Automation Important And Useful?



- **Cost Savings** - Integration between systems helps reduce cost in the long run as it reduces manual effort
- **Error Reduction** - The integration will automate your data workflow. It will do exactly what you tell it to do every time
- **Scalability & Efficiency** - Data sharing will help your organization scale faster and automate low-value tasks
- **Standardization** - Integrating the various systems across your organization will encourage you to streamline and standardize your operations/data
- **Security** - Automation is excellent at keeping information private as humans aren't generally involved



Opportunities For Personal Integration



- Using Outlook rules to categorize, label, and organize your email Inbox
- Using Alexa to turn off the lights in your home at the end of the day as you get in bed
- Using Amazon or HP to order replacement toner/paper for your printer when running low
- Using Microsoft Power Automate to automatically process changes from your accounting system to your various other company systems
- Using a Stream Deck to launch your favorite applications at the push of a button
- **Any frequently done task is a great candidate for automation and integration**



When Should You Not Integrate And Automate Your Data



Generally, integration between systems is considered a good thing. However, there are some exceptions. Some things to consider:

- **Highly Manual & Complex** - Transactions that are highly varied and require substantial human review. For example, evaluating artwork or listening to audio
- **Not Standard** - When the data format isn't consistent and can't be standardized
- **Some Systems Don't Support Integration** - Some older and legacy systems don't have the necessary components to allow data to be systematically imported or exported
- **Changing Requirements** - Generally, you don't want to start integrating data until all the requirements are established and agreed to
- **Upfront Costs** - Integration projects can have a higher up-front cost. Generally, these costs are one-time and fixed. However, the price can be cost-prohibitive for some projects

Features Of Good Integration



- **Scalability in the Future** - Can it grow with your organization?
- **Complete Traceability** - Can you trace a transaction from start to finish? Can you see where the data is going?
- **Failure Recovery** - Are there safeguards to ensure the system can recover and data isn't lost?
- **System Upgrades** - Can you change systems inside your organization without causing significant disruption? For example, changing accounting systems
- **Change in Business Process** - Can your integration change as your organization changes? Is it flexible enough to deal with minor changes to the data without requiring significant alterations?

What To Look For When Integrating



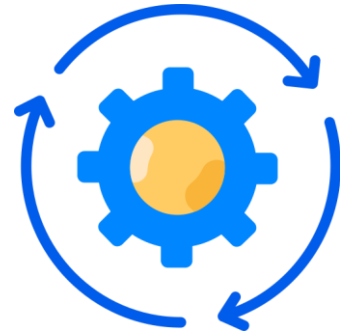
- **Repetitive** - Tasks that are done a lot or in high frequency
- **Simple** - Tasks that are clearly defined and standardized
- **Timely** - A task that needs to be done on a schedule where timeliness matters
- **Prone to Error** - Tasks are usually prone to clerical or human errors
- **Security** - Tasks involving sensitive data that would not be suitable for humans to be involved (e.g., storing a password, charging a credit card, etc.)
- **Stored in a System** - Tasks that are already contained inside a system and a database

Discover Your Repetitive Tasks



- Make a list of daily, weekly, and monthly tasks
- Determine how many times each task is completed per day
- Are those tasks completed the same way every time?
- What are the requirements of tasks?
 - What do they require to be completed?
- Who is responsible for completing that task?



Evaluate Your Repetitive Tasks



- Determine what would be gained by automating the task
- Will automation reduce errors?
- Will automation save time?
- Will it allow a workflow to be tracked more easily?
- Will a human double-check still be required?
- Analyzing why you want to automate a task helps you find the right tool to automate the task with



Getting Started With Integration And Automation For Personal Work



There are several tools and services which you can start using. From the novice to the expert, there is a toolset for you

- **Integration Platforms** - IFTTT, Zapier, and Power Automate, n8n, Zoho Flow
- **Desktop Tools** - Excel, Word, Outlook, Adobe Acrobat DC, Calendly, Liscio, and more
- **Intelligent Virtual Assistants** - Amazon Alexa, Google Home, and Apple Siri



Three Primary Types Of Automation



Digital Process Automation

- DPA seeks to digitize end-to-end processes
- Purpose is to optimize and streamline workflows
- Often automates content flows from completed forms

Robotic Process Automation

- Uses technology to automate tasks human workers might perform
- Examples include extracting data, form-filling, moving files from one storage location to another

Business Process Automation

- Generally, BPA is more complex than either DPA or RPA
- BPA for example might be used to automate credit approval decisions

Examples



- DPA
 - A customer or client fills in an on-line form. DPA could be used to extract and store that data elsewhere. This should be a relatively simple process because the fillable form structures the data
- RPA
 - A public accounting firm might use RPA to extract data from clients' tax documents such as W-2s, 1099's, and K-1s and automatically populate a tax return with the data
- BPA
 - Automating A/P workflows through automatically approving payments

ODBC – An Automation Facilitator



- Automation efforts sometimes require **linking data from one database or application to another**
- This task is sometimes completed by **Open Database Connectivity (ODBC)**, somewhat of a “legacy” technology
- ODBC is a **vendor-neutral way of linking data** from one location to another
- A common use of ODBC is **automating reporting processes, such as linking accounting data to Excel for reporting purposes**



LET'S SEE AN EXAMPLE...

Using ODBC To Link Data



- Perhaps you want to create a report in Power BI or even Excel that **uses data from your QuickBooks Desktop database**
 - Of course, **you want to link the data**, not export it/import
 - By linking **you can refresh your report on demand**
- To do this using ODBC, you'll need a connector such as one available from [CData](#)

Using ODBC To Link Data



- In Excel and with QuickBooks open, click **Get Data** from the **Data** tab of the Ribbon
- Choose **From Other Sources, From ODBC**
- Specify the **CData QuickBooks Source**
- **Expand the folders**
- **Click the table** to link to Excel
- Create your report
- Once created, you only need to **refresh the report, not rebuild**

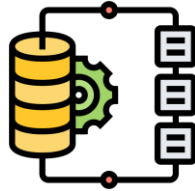

USEFUL AUTOMATION & INTEGRATION TOOLS FOR BUSINESS

Often There Is Automation Inside Applications You're Already Using



Most applications have various methods to automate routine tasks or make complicated actions easier

- **Templates** - You memorize commonly used or customized formats and reports
- **Macros** - You can record your actions and keystrokes and play them back
- **Rules & Filters** - You can set up procedures to categorize and organize your work
- **Communication** - You can set up actions to communicate about your work through email or chat
- **Integration with third-party tools** - It's common to integrate external tools to provide additional functionality or data



Examples Of Built-In Automation



You can find automation everywhere!

- Categorizing email through rules or filters in your preferred Email Client
- Saving your common searches or views in Explorer, Outlook, etc.
- Recording actions with a macro in documents and spreadsheets
- Creating templates of your commonly used documents in Microsoft Office, Google Workspace, etc.
- Using simple batch, Bash, or PowerShell Scripts in your operating system
- Use Windows Task Scheduler or iOS Background Task to launch tasks automatically
- Adding your commonly used functions to the quick access toolbar in Office
- Using the sharing functionality of any application

Examples of integration and automation features

- Macros and user-defined functions can automate the tasks you repeatedly do
- Power Automate can significantly improve your process of extracting, transforming, and loading data inside of Excel
- There are countless third-party add-ins to assist with reporting and processing inside the application
- You can use the quick action toolbar to pin your most-used shortcuts
- Flash Fill can automatically fill your data when it recognizes a pattern
- Analyze Data and Recommended Pivot Tables can help you better understand your data

Examples of integration and automation features

- You can use Styles to easily, quickly, and consistently apply visual appearance to your documents and presentations
- You can use the quick action toolbar to pin your most-used shortcuts
- The “reuse content” and template function allows you to leverage and repurpose previously written content/documents
- Mail merge, table of content, etc., functionality automatically performs complicated actions that take forever to accomplish manually
- There are countless third-party tools available in the Microsoft Store to extend Word’s capabilities
- You can request signatures on documents with the Adobe Acrobat DC plugin

Quick steps and rules for automation

- Quick Steps apply multiple actions at the same time to email messages. This helps you quickly manage your mailbox
- For example, if you frequently move messages to a specific folder, you can use a Quick Step to move the message in one click. Or, if you forward messages to your manager or peers, a one-click Quick Step can simplify the task
- You can also use rules to apply actions automatically to future incoming messages
- You can use the quick action toolbar to pin your most-used shortcuts
- There are countless third-party tools available in the Microsoft Store to extend Outlook’s capabilities



Automation And Integration Option Inside Microsoft Teams



- Microsoft Teams is the “grand central station” of communication. It brings together chat, voice, video, and file collaboration for an organization
- It has a ton of automation and integration functionality throughout the application. It offers excellent connectivity to other applications both in and outside the 365 ecosystems
- Just using Teams, you can have access to communicate with your whole organization, collaborate on documents in real-time, access data in third-party systems, approve documents, and more

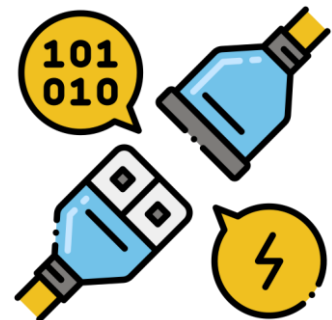


Connectors Inside Teams

Connect Teams to Anything!



- In a nutshell, connectors allow you to connect with Teams to external applications
- Connectors keep your team current by delivering content and updates from services you frequently use directly into a channel. With connectors, your Teams users can receive updates from popular services such as Trello, Wunderlist, GitHub, and Azure DevOps Services in their Teams chats
- Use Third-party apps to create automation: Flow bot, Zapier, Slack
- Use Connectors to pull status updates into Teams from non-Microsoft products

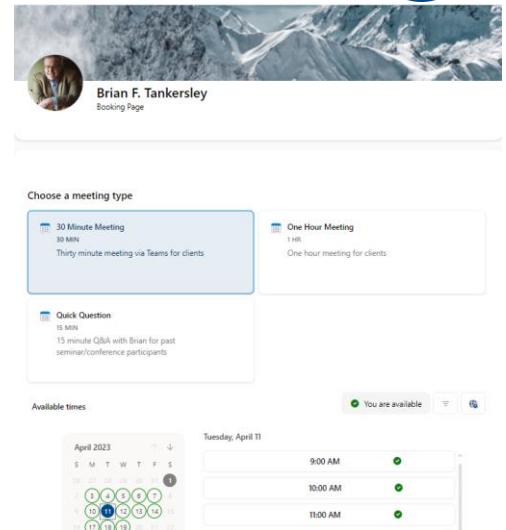

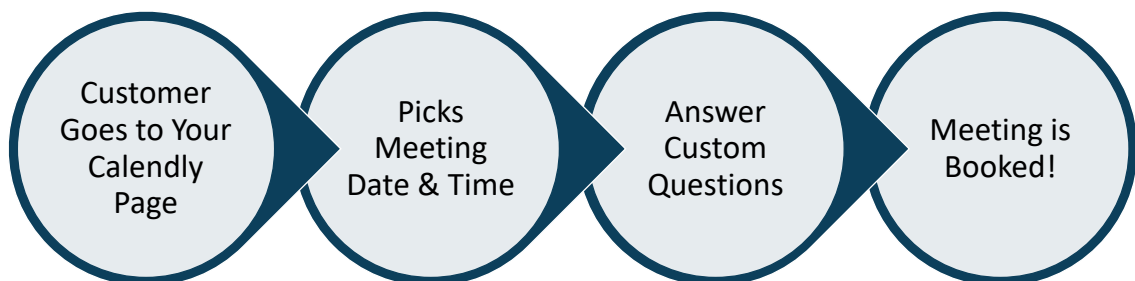

- Each meeting type can have unique characteristics

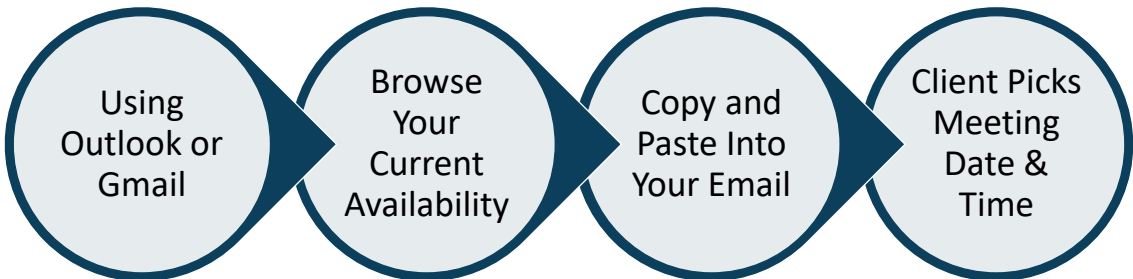
- The client sees your up-to-the-minute availability coming from 365, Google or both
- They pick a date and time that works for them, but they only can choose the times your available

- You can ask questions such as the intention of the meeting, collect payment, or anything else
- Can choose the location of the meeting, virtual or a physical location

- When the user schedules the meeting, an email is sent to you and them
- A calendar invitation with all event details is sent to everybody

Power Query And Automation

- Microsoft's **Power Query tool offers automation opportunities** that are readily adaptable to many situations
- Think of Power Query as a “generic” tool you can use to automate many of your **data extraction and manipulation needs**
- Fortunately, **Power Query became “fully-baked” into Excel beginning with the 2016 release** of the application

Power Query And Automation



- What can we do with Power Query?
 - **Link** data from external data sources
 - **Manipulate** that data with “transformations”
 - **Combine** data
 - **Create** “refreshable” reports
 - **Construct** data models
- From an automation perspective, all the above mean **if we can get a “project” – often a report – right one time, we never have to rebuild it...we merely refresh it**

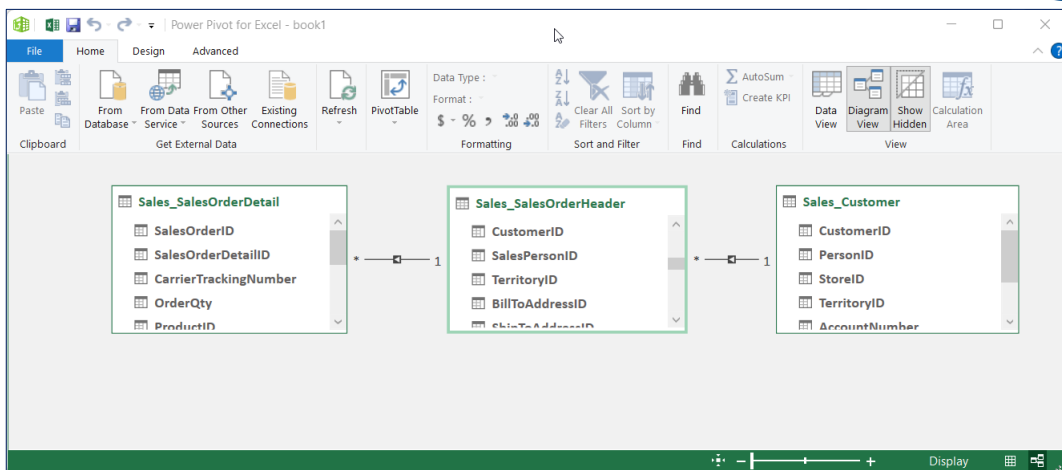
- Use Power Query to link data from multiple tables in a database, **delete unnecessary columns, join the tables** in a data model, and **summarize the data** using a PivotTable
- Steps
 - **Data, Get Data, From Database, From Microsoft Access Database, AdventureWorks Data.accdb, Import**
 - Choose **Select Multiple Items**
 - Select the **Sales_Customer, SalesOrderHeader, and SalesOrderDetails** tables
 - Click **Transform Data**

An Example...Continued



- **Apply transformations** such as sorting, filtering, deleting columns, adding user-defined calculations, etc.
- Click **Close and Load**
- **Utilize PowerPivot to join the tables into a data model**
- **Generate your report**

Power Automate And “Flows”



- In Power Automate, “**flow**” to describes the automated workflows run in the service
- The three primary types of flows are:
 1. **Automated flows**, which occur when a specific event – “trigger” – happens or occurs
 2. **Instant cloud flows**, which run when a manual trigger occurs
 3. **Scheduled cloud flows**, which run on a designated schedule

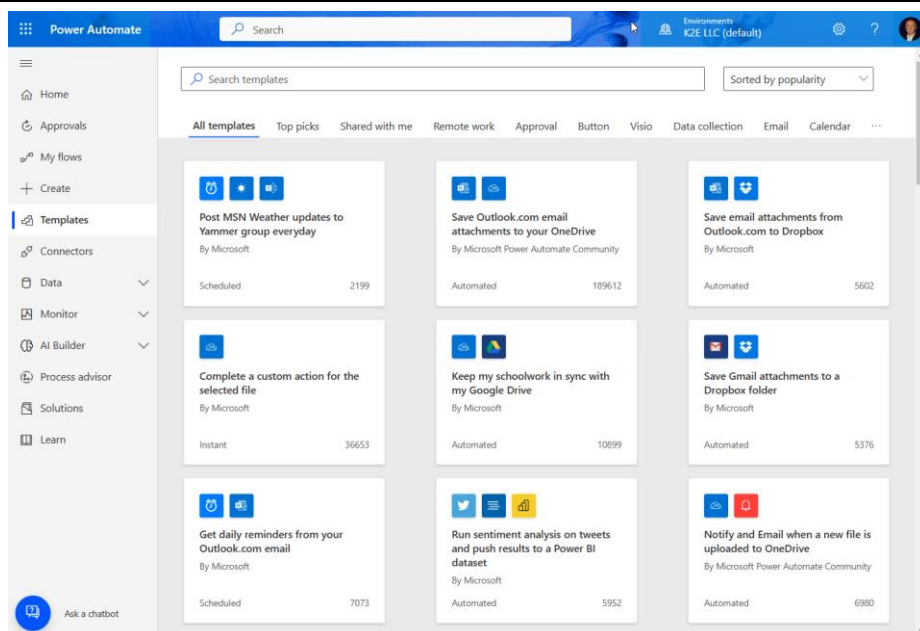

- Trigger, a new invoice is created in QBO. Action, iPaaS tool posts a message in Teams to let the sales team know
- Trigger, an invoice is paid in QBO. Action, iPaaS tool updates the customer record showing the invoice as being paid in QBO and updates an Excel workbook tracking AR

- **Group everyday actions together into profiles** - Create profiles for each application or function you do. For example, a profile-specific for Excel, your favorite websites, or preparing a financial statement
- A profile allows you to access targeted functionality easily

Which Stream Deck Is Right For You? What Should You Get?



- **Stream Deck Mini** - \$59 – 6 buttons. This would be useful for straightforward workflows but is probably too small for most operations
- **Stream Deck** - \$149 – 15 buttons. This is the standard size and will be a good option for most users
- **Stream Deck XL** - \$199 – 32 buttons. This larger size will be significantly appreciated by power users who want a higher level of configuration
- Additional options would be the mobile app (\$24.99/year) for iOS and Android Additionally, the Stream Deck Pedal (\$89) is for foot control of actions

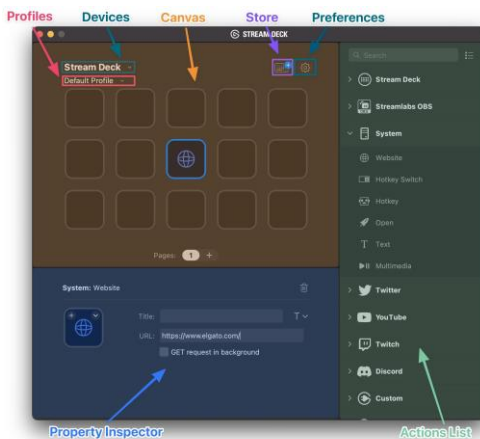
Buttons, Action, Plugins, & Profiles



Making your Stream Deck uniquely yours

- **Buttons** are the visual representation of an action. They can have a custom name, icon and locate anywhere on the Stream Deck
- **Actions** do something for you. For example, it can be opening an application, launching a website, etc.
- **Multi-Actions** allow you to do multiple things at once. For example, you can open multiple applications with a single button push. Alternatively, you could send an email with a push-button and archive the message
- **Folders** contain multiple buttons to make organization easy
- **Plugins** are third-party tools that extend the Stream Deck's underlying functionality. The community submits many plugins for free
- **Profiles** are like big folders but are more easily navigable

How To Use A Stream Deck



- **Actions list:** sidebar containing a list of all the actions provided by the installed plugins
- **Canvas:** grid displaying the keys containing actions (the size of the grid will change depending on the device)
- **Property Inspector:** form area, available to the currently selected key in the canvas where you can customize the icon, title, and action settings
- **Devices:** dropdown showing available devices
- **Profiles:** user stored key layouts selected from a dropdown on the canvas
- **Store:** store button that navigates to the app store where users can find plugins, assets, etc. to use with their Stream Deck
- **Preferences:** opens a menu where you can change Stream Deck settings

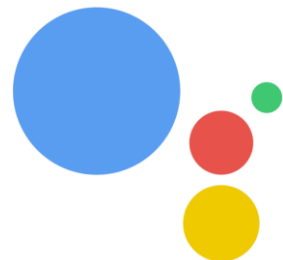

Google Assistant



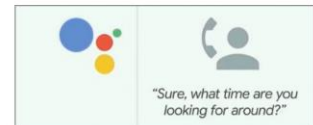
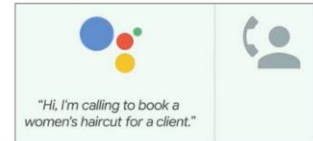
- Google Assistant is available in more than 90 countries and over 30 languages and is used by more than 500 million users monthly

- Manage home devices
- Create Smart Home groups to control devices easier
- Using Home groups gives on/off capabilities only
- Have Alexa tell you about upcoming appointments
- Manage announcements
- Automatically play music, give traffic or weather updates
- Use the Wait command to pause in between actions
- Select which device you want to perform any given action

The open-source modular mirror system

- A magic mirror is a FREE, open-source intelligent display system that can display information about your life, work, and family. While not technically an IVA, it's super helpful and insightful
- It can display your upcoming calendar appointments, emails in your Inbox, billable time, favorite photos, and more!
- It is endlessly configurable and can be completely customized to meet the user's exact needs
- All you need is a spare display and a Raspberry Pi. The software is free
